

Minutes of September 8, 2008

Meeting called to order at 7:20 p.m. Members present Phil Famiglietti, Chairman, Todd Annis, Bob Norris, Chris Kervick and Dave Farr, Recreation Director.

Motion made to approve June minutes. Motion seconded. All in favor. August minutes read. Motion made by Bob Norris to approve minutes as read. Motion second by Chris Kervick. Motion approved. All in favor.

Dave discussed with Commission package regarding pool house that was signed off on. Discussion with Commission meeting and discussion with Scott at Public Works. Chairman Famiglietti voiced concern regarding drains. Mr. Farr stated he has not visited area recently to observe any landscaping done. Commission agreed the one entire room designated as possible lifeguard and staff lounge area should not be without any electrical outlets. Mr. Farr to pass on concerns to Scott and Public Works. Mr. Farr to contact Mr. Netto to confer and finalize to type final draft of 5-yr. plan capital items for next meeting. Mr. Farr and Mr. Kervick to meet at Pesci to review and discuss projected lighting project. Brief discussion regarding well irrigation project at North Street development.

Dave to contact familiar outfit for estimate regarding North Street well then to proceed to Denslow Park for test regarding irrigation there. Mr. Farr to have well estimates for next meeting.

Motion made by Todd Annis to accept single panel proposal from Shock Electrical Contractors for a single meter as stated in contract proposal. Motion seconded by Bob Norris. Motion approved as stated. All in favor.

Commission went on to review proposal from Mrs. Gianuzzi for a Social and Cultural space in town similar to a community meeting place. Mr. Kervick and Commission directed Mr. Farr to receive more specific details regarding proposal.

Mr. Farr reported on soccer program numbers. Extra law enforcement visible especially evenings at Family Park with unwanted traffic showing improvement. Mr. Farr to suggest to save expenses shutting down lights at Family Park basketball court at 8:30 p.m. with school back in session and off completely after dark once clocks get turned back. Family Day to be held September 14. Next meeting to be held tentatively Tuesday, October 14 due to the holiday.

Construction at VMP in progress to make new structure more presentable and pillars being installed along both sides of driveway to prevent parking along sides of entry.
