

Minutes of January 12, 2009

Meeting called to order at 7:10 p.m. Members present Phil Famiglietti, Chairman, Bob Norris, Todd Annis and Dave Farr, Recreation Director.

Due to lack of quorum the members present went on to discuss the following matters.

Mark Cenci of 42 Sadler Street addressed Commission regarding the use of Noden Reed park property by snowmobilers posing a trespassing violation. Present signs on property appear to be ineffective with more and more unauthorized vehicles using property. Mr. Cenci suggested Public Works install additional and larger signs at entrances to property prohibiting use of unauthorized vehicles. A major concern is a possible liability issue at the property.

Mr. Farr reported final connection to transformer needed to complete lights project at Pesci. Utility company to install pole, job able to be completed in a day pending weather conditions.

Mr. Farr reported on meeting with architect regarding proposed floor plans for renovations and improvements to Pesci Pavilion. Mr. Farr to have initial figures in approximately week and a half.

Commission accepted resignation of Bill Latorra from Commission effective immediately. Chris Kervick to hold office of Judge of Probate preventing him from holding seat on Commission.

Mr. Farr reported on recent thank you responses from the Gilbert Family and the Netto Family both expressing thanks for the Commission's expressions of sympathy to both families.

Mr. Farr reported on upcoming four team collegiate baseball league to begin consisting of players ages 19-25. Recreation basketball and belly-dancing programs in progress. Liner in at VMP pavilion for skating, ice expected to be frozen and complete by end of the week.
