

Minutes of July 13, 2009

Meeting called to order at 7:07 p.m. Members present Phil Famiglietti, Chairman, Mike Tedone, Bob Norris, Darren Netto and Dave Farr, Recreation Director.

Minutes of June meeting read with correction made to last paragraph to read next meeting to be held Monday, July 13. Motion made by Mr. Netto to then accept June minutes as read. Motion second by Bob Norris. Motion unanimous. All in favor.

Mr. Farr reported on enrichment programs being held at North Street School. Commission discussed the three proposed capital improvement items created with some combining of programs. Mr. Farr to investigate figures further including press box item to be proposed and to report back with several estimates needed.

Commission discussed approved skatepark project to be constructed at the lower tennis courts of the high school. Mr. Farr to attend upcoming advisory meeting regarding new skatepark. Members briefly reviewed skatepark rules from various skateparks in the vicinity.

Mr. Farr reported on conflicts with summer tennis program instructor regarding wrong weeks and dates of said instruction. Overall program not working out Mr. Farr to go elsewhere for instructor in future.

Director Farr reported on VMP lights fuse box issue and problems associated with running all lights systems together.

Pesci Summer Day Camp going well. Southwest Family Park basketball lights staying on later than approved, to look into timer status.

Commissioners reported playground equipment at Woodland St. Park in good shape. Suggested the possibility of replacing rocks at Southwest Family Park with shavings similar to Denslow Park. Mr. Tedone reported on unsafe playground equipment at Juniper Park along with fencing in need of replacing there. Chairman Famiglietti reported on ongoing issue of chain fencing missing and in need of replacing at parking lot area of Southwest Family Park.
