

Minutes of February 8, 2010

Meeting began at 7:06 p.m. Members present Darren Netto, Assistant Chairman, Mike Tedone, Bob Norris, Rich Labbe, Dave Farr, Recreation Director and Steve Wawruck, First Selectman.

Motion made by Mike Tedone to accept January minutes as read with the following corrections to costs associated with the 5-Year Plan: Veteran's Memorial Park Press Box project should read \$260,715.00 and Pesci Concession Stand project should read \$181,181.00. Motion seconded by Bob Norris. All in favor.

Mr. Farr updated the commission on the Skateboard Park Project stating bids would be opened on Friday, February 12, 2010, at 11:00 a.m. Mr. Wawruck asked several questions about the final nature of the park which were answered by Mr. Farr. There were concerns regarding the project's ability to stay within budget.

Rich Labbe made a motion to give the Park Director a 2% salary increase and to reduce programming to \$159,230. The motion was seconded by Bob Norris.

Mr. Farr gave his report with focus on the completion of the Lights Project at Veteran's Memorial Park. He will meet with Scott Lappen, Director of Public Works, and Joe LaPierre, Electrician, to address lighting issues and obtain a breakdown of cost.

Mr. Farr shared two emails from Little League President, Dan Squires. Mr. Farr will meet with Scott Lappen to discuss the requests and coordinate which work can be done by volunteers.

Darren Netto reported on the CIAC meeting and their request for a cost estimate on the Pesci Pavilion Project covering only the bathroom renovation. Mr. Farr is waiting for a better estimate.

There were no reports from commissioners.

Bob Norris made motion to adjourn at 8:09 p.m. Motion seconded by Rich Labbe. All in favor. Next meeting to be held Monday, March 8, 2010 7:00 p.m.
