

Minutes of September 13, 2010

Sinking fund ideas discussed along with additional suggestions. Thoughts presented and direction in which to go made for upcoming meeting.

Mr. Farr explained power to be shut off at VMP building in order to complete amperage problem at VMP lighted fields, transformer is in place. Mr. Farr discussed field lights fees and bills. Family Day went very well this year. The new secretary is working at office with Melanie training her in the mornings. Issue with parking at VMP with soccer fields and baseball fields in high use. Mr. Farr to distribute flyers with designated times for youth soccer to alleviate parking problems. Bob O'Connor plaque to go up in either the fall or spring. Jim Pearce to purchase poles to erect new soccer scoreboard. Park office to move to the visiting nurses wing. Mr. Farr to present new policy after going through human resources regarding volunteering such as coaches and requiring background checks and first aid programs.
