After an alarming increase in Domestic Violence in 2010 - 2011 (66.1%), the WLPD partnered with the Network Against Domestic Abuse in Enfield. The decrease can be attributed to the "Lethality Assessment Program" started in 2012 as a result of this partnership.

District Area checks are a patrol of the Residential Districts & Business. Residents notice these checks more in the evening hours when the Police Cruisers have their cruise lights on. Increased patrolling has resulted in a decrease in crimes of opportunity.
