NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (Department) will conduct a Public Information Meeting in Windsor Locks concerning improvements to the Windsor Locks Railroad Station. The meeting will be on Thursday, September 19, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. in the Ella T. Grasso Conference Room at the Windsor Locks Town Hall.

The **Windsor Locks Railroad Station Improvements Project** will construct a new railroad station platform in the Town of Windsor Locks (Town) as well as make other needed infrastructure improvements. The relocation to downtown and upgrades of the Windsor Locks Station is a critical component of the state's plans for the expansion of rail passenger service on the New Haven-Hartford-Springfield Rail Line (NHHS).

This station will include a 510 foot-long, ADA compliant, level boarding heated platform, a multi-use trail with connections to the Windsor Locks Canal State Park Trail via Bridge Street, a new 162 spaced parking lot with 15 electrical vehicle charging stations, ticket vending machines, and passenger waiting areas. This project also includes a "complete streets" roadway improvement of Route 159 to become the backbone for the new Transit Oriented District within Windsor Locks and a vital link to a walkable downtown.

Construction is scheduled to begin in the fall of 2020 and be completed in late 2022. The approximate cost of this work is \$65,000,000.00.

Plans will be available for public review and department personnel will be available during the meeting to discuss this project. More detailed information is available at the Department's Office of Engineering, 2800 Berlin Turnpike, Newington, CT during office hours, Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., excluding holidays. 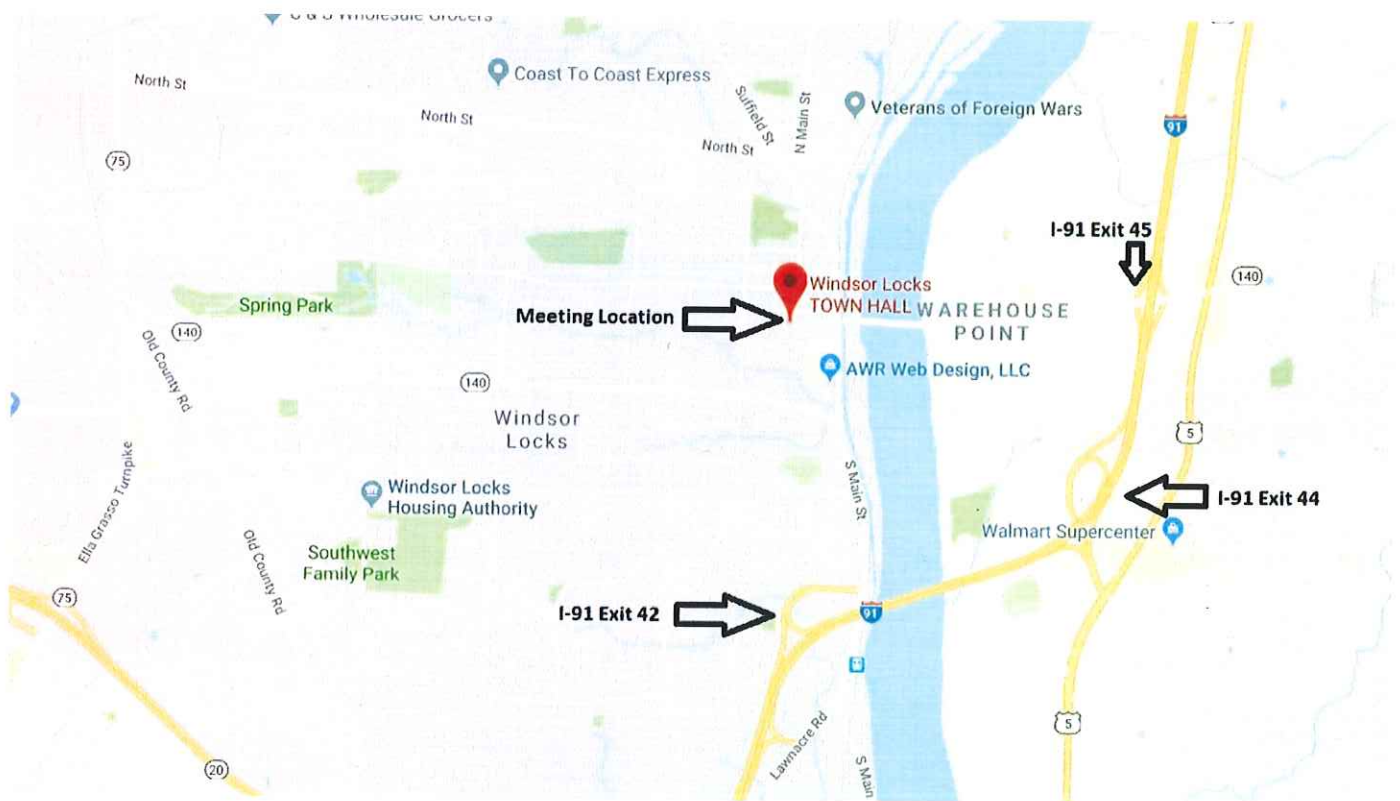
