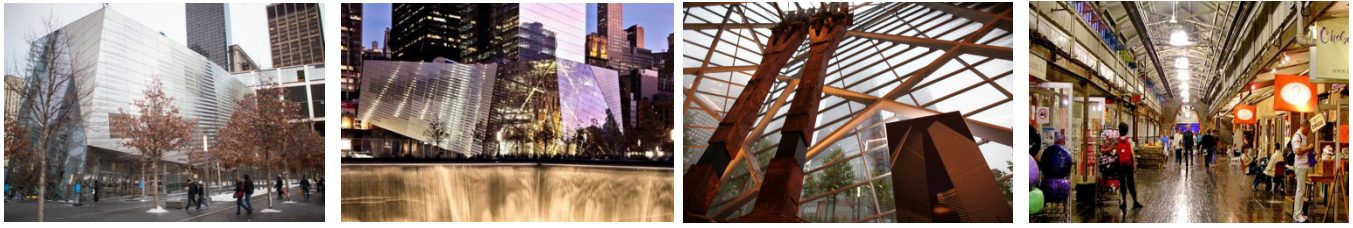

NATIONAL SEPTEMBER 11 MEMORIAL MUSEUM MAY 15, 2016

The National September 11 Museum, serves as the country's principal institution concerned with exploring the implications of the events of 9/11, documenting the impact of those events and exploring 9/11's continuing significance. The Museum displays artifacts associated with the events of 9/11, while presenting stories of loss and recovery.

The 9/11 Memorial's twin reflecting pools are each nearly an acre in size and feature the largest manmade waterfalls in North America and sit within the footprints of where the Twin Towers once stood. The names of every person who died in the 2001 and 1993 attacks are inscribed on bronze panels around the edges of the Memorial pools, this being the reminder of the largest loss of life resulting from a foreign attack on American soil.

Visit **Chelsea Marketplace**, where you will have time for lunch on own. Feel free to explore the High Line (which can be accessed through the back of Chelsea Market). The High Line is a public park that was built from an historic elevated freight rail line that went above the streets of Manhattan's West Side. There are beautiful public gardens here.
