VI. Other Business

21 Cortland – Single Family Home has been issued a CO from Zoning & Building Departments, with recommendations to Wetlands that vegetation be inspected periodically to ensure that it establishes. Commission thinks it prudent to inform new home owner about the wetlands on property and concerns.

Briarcliff – inundated back yard has been inspected further by Public Works, determining that under-road infrastructure is the cause of water seepage after scoping the pipes of the neighborhood. Costly upgrades and repairs are needed for neighborhood; the conditions will be monitored in the interim.

Walking Tour of UConn’s Low-Impact Development was attended by Town staff and members of the Commission on October 30th, viewing storm-water retention, green roofs, and concrete, pavement, & paver stone design alternatives that reduce impervious surface and help filtrate water naturally on site. Photographs from everyone will be compiled and shared with Commission members.

Main Street Trash Rack – Commission requested that Staff explore DOT responsibility for maintenance.
