**PUBLIC INPUT:** None**APPROVAL OF THE SEPTEMBER 4, 2018 REGULAR MINUTES:**

***Selectmen Rachele moved that September 4, 2018 minutes be approved as published. Selectmen Kervick seconded the motion. The vote was two in favor (Selectmen Rachele & Kervick), and one abstention (Selectman Hill). Motion carried.***

**CORRESPONDENCE:** None**OLD BUSINESS:**a) ***John Chapman Event Update:***

List of attendees are getting wrapped up, to include Governor Dannel P. Malloy, United States Representatives John Larson and Joseph Courtney. USAF Colonial Tudor, Jr. and Chief Master Sergeant Guilmain will be key note speakers. Commissioner Saadi, Connecticut's Department of Veterans Affairs, will present the dedication address at Memorial Hall. Donations are coming in. A press release should be released within a few days to inform the town of the ceremony.

b) ***Suffield Street traffic:***

Speed signs will be placed, as well as vehicles and trucks will be monitored. Selectman Rachele also mentioned "blind person" signage was requested by a home owner, and since has been approved by the Police Commission and will be placed near the resident's property.

c) ***All Sports Village Update:***

Has filed an amended general plan of development. If approved, DOT will then review access issues. Waiting on financial proposal in which it is believed they will ask for tax abatement or pledging of tax revenue. They will be requested to present a proposal at a Board of Selectmen's meeting.

d) ***Route 75 Sidewalk and Crosswalk Update:***

DOT had agreed to add crosswalks to the sidewalk project. DOT expects finished plans, specification package and cost estimate by Wednesday September 19, 2018. DOT policy prohibits going to bid until easements are in place.

- e) **TOD Grant:**  
 The geotechnical team subcontractor has mentioned that piers be placed within the retaining wall project. There will be a meeting at the Town Hall on September 20, for the design plan bid.
- f) **Phase 2 of the LOTCIP Grant:**  
 Application has been awarded in the amount of \$2.5million dollars. The State will be covering the bike and pedestrian grant.
- g) **Public market:**  
 The Town has been denied the USDA grant that would give funds to help pay for the business plan.
